Responsibilities

- Available remotely for 4-5 hours per week during office hours. Additional hours possible, as needed
- Design social media content according to training schedule and social media strategy; this includes posts and short-form videos
- Manage social media schedule
- Interact with DCPT's social media comments and wider community in a manner consistent with the organization's brand; escalate comments or questions as needed
- Track and analyze social media performance

- Contribute to social media strategy
- May also have opportunities to represent organization at community events
- Support other programmatic initiatives, as needed

- You are passionate about advancing justice and peace
- You are a creative self-starter and great communicator
- You are culturally competent and sensitive to diversity, inclusion, and equity
